

Provided below is information on the DOT physical exam requirements required for CDPs and CDLs.

When applying for a CDL or CDL Permit in Indiana, individuals must provide a valid Medical Examination Report (MER) and Medical Examiner's Certificate (MEC). The BMV only accepts the MER and MEC if completed by a medical examiner certified by the FMCSA National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners. Applicants must provide both the MER and MEC.

1. UrgentCare Indy (317) 960- 3278. (7911 N Michigan Rd, Indianapolis IN 46268)
 - a. Performs DOT approved physicals for \$95.
 - b. Must call office *first* to ensure a DOT Certified Provider is on site.
 - c. The attached forms are required by the BMV, and *must be brought to the physical exam to be completed by the physician.*
2. Completed Physical exam documents are submitted to the BMV via one of the following methods:
